Etiquette

- BoonDocking in the "boonies"
 - Park in previously used areas
 - Park away from others, give them space
 - Respect quiet hours
 - Leave area cleaner than when you arrive

Etiquette

- Blacktop BoonDocking
 - Ask permission
 - Purchase fuel, groceries or other items
 - Do not put out awning
 - Stay only one night
 - Leave area cleaner than when you arrived

Security

- Blacktop BoonDocking
 - Park under lights, doors facing the light
 - Park in middle of lot, not on edges
 - Talk to security personnel so they know you
 - Be ready to move forward if needed, no stabilizers down
 - Cell phone charged and ready
 - We have camped many times at Wal-marts, Cracker Barrels, Bass Pro Shops, and Cabela's with no problems
 - Have never camped at rest stops

Security

- Don't have your name and address outside rig
- Don't advertise that you are a full-timer
- Normally, the further you are from civilization, the safer you are




Power

- Good batteries, change 3 years or less
- Install LED lamps
- Minimum number lights on at once
- Read during daylight, campfire at night
- Catalytic heater vs. furnace
- Mattress heating pad & down comforter
- Water pump switch on when using water

Fresh Water

- Fresh Water tank normally will last 5-6 days
- Take "Navy or G.I." showers, use wipes for basics
- Install "shut-off" valve on shower head and an Oxygenics shower head
- 2-1/2 gallon folding containers for water w/o pump
- One-pot meals or Dutch oven
- Disposable plates
- Catch cold water while waiting for hot water
- Run water only when needed i.e. brushing teeth
- Use "renewable" ice cubes

Black Water

- Black water tank will last 5-7days
- Use public facilities
- Use dishwater to flush

Wash Water

- Wash Water Tank will last 4-5 days
- Use dishpan and throw dishwater on ground
- Dump on ground where permitted, every day to reduce odor
- Same items that conserve water, reduce amount of wash water

Stay Warm

- Cool weather-park in sun or go South
- Mattress pad and down comforter
- Wear socks and cap to bed
- Flannel or jersey sheets
- Stay close to your partner
- Catalytic heater
- Water heater foil insulation on windows
- Styrofoam blocks in skylights

Stay Cool

- Hot weather-park in shade or go North
- Fantastic fans to vent, close front windows an leave bedroom windows open
- Fan in bedroom blowing on or around you

Food and Cooking

- Dutch oven cooking is great
 - Doesn't require propane
 - Doesn't require water to wash Dutch oven
 - One pot meals possible



Practice Boondocking

- Set up in your driveway or a campground and practice boondocking
- Disconnect from electric, water, and sewer
- Get a feel as to how long your batteries last
- How long water lasts
