How to Get on a Caravan

Sign on, up to two plus years ahead

– Some only run every two years

Don't be afraid to get on stand-by list

Be ready to go!

Cancellations and Refunds

- Possibly \$50-100 cancellation fee before certain date
- Pay Non-reimbursable expenses if no one from stand-by list able to replace you

What is Included in the Cost – Kitty Fee?

- All camping
- Normally at least one meal per stop
- Normally an activity per day
- Expenses of the leader (those not "compensated" by vendor) and mileage

Finances

- Leaders provide budget at beginning of caravan
- Near end of caravan two or three caravan members review financials
- Leaders receive mileage and expenses not compensated by vendors
- Leaders return unspent money to caravan members





Normal Day on a Caravan

- Stay at each location range from 2-5 days, average 3 days



What is a Driver's Meeting?

- Meeting before move to next location
- Review route
- Discuss possible route problems or things to see and do
- Discuss activities at next location
- Discuss locations of stores, medical, fuel
- Critique current stop, add, delete, or just right

Things to have on a Caravan

- Normal camping clothes, not forma, Prepare for all temperatures and conditions
- Water Hose 25' and 50'
- Electric Hook-up cable, Normal length
- 50 amp to 30 amp and 20 amp to 30 amp connectors
- Sewer Dump Hose, Normal Length
- Possibly a CB Radio
